School Uniform

Following a discussion with some of our pupils, we would like to send out a general reminder about the expectations that we have of school uniform. The uniform at Bottisham Primary School is as follows:

- A red or white polo shirt / shirt / blouse (with or without the school logo)
- A red sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without the school logo)
- Black or charcoal grey trousers / shorts / skirt / culottes
- Summer – red and white checked dress

For PE lessons, the uniform is:

White t-shirt
Black or navy shorts
Black or navy jogging bottoms
Trainers or plimsolls

This uniform applies to all our pupils from Nursery to Year 6. Plain polo shirts and sweatshirts can be purchased at a variety of retailers including some supermarket chains. If you would like to purchase uniform with the school logo on, then you can do so via our website at
